Does tuition have to be out of reach...not when you use SCRIP!

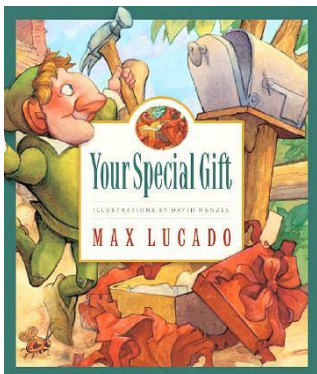
This program has been running since October with tremendous success for our families and the school. To date the school has collected close to \$550 towards the general fund while our families have accumulated approximately \$400. One family will be using their SCRIP balance to pay the 2010-11 kindergarten registration fee. Another family is buying SCRIP before their child is attending to get a head start on reducing their tuition. Anyone can participate and it is easy to get started. SCRIP is a fundraiser without the popcorn, chocolate, or wrapping paper. MVCA is able to buy gift cards/certificates at a discount, sell them at full face value, and the difference is credited to either a family's tuition account or the school's general fund. Rebates range from 1.5 to 22 percent. *It is a win-win for you and the school!*

Lace up your running or walking shoes and join us for our 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual *RACE FOR CHRIST* to be held on Saturday, April 3<sup>rd</sup>. Bring your family, neighbors, and friends to run in a 5K or 10K race or a 5K walk for fun and exercise. For kids 10 and under there will be a half mile fun run. The 5K walk/run and 10K run will start at 11:00 a.m. at the Summit Activities Center and finish on Williams Field (both adjacent to Yankton High School). There will be a pre-race dinner Friday evening at MVCA (305 W. 25<sup>th</sup> St.) at a cost of \$5 per plate.
